Competition Rules and Regulations

The theme for the competition is "Pennsylvania's Got Talent", taken from the official "America's Got Talent" television series. It's our way for you the Competitor to help showcase Pennsylvania's finest Barber and Cosmetology talent. Instead of competing with one another, we want you to display the craft as a group of artists. This Competition will be judged both visually and with a brief explanation by each Team's lead Competitor of your work based on the idea or theme that was created by you the Competitor as a guide for your School's team.

NAILS: The nail-art of the Model is to be done "on-site". The Sages will view the nails prior to the start and at the completion of this segment.

There are 30 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. Nail extensions may be pre-applied before the Competition start.
2. The base shade of polish may be pre-applied before the Competition start.
3. Only two-dimensional nail art should be applied during the Competition.
4. Toenails may be included in the final judging.

MAKE-UP: The make-up for the female Model will be done prior to the "Hairstyling" segment.

There are 30 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. Model's skin should be prepared for make-up prior to the Competition start.
 - a. The pre-application of skin preparation is permitted.
 - b. The pre-application of any make-up or artificial lashes is not permitted.
2. The make-up application should include the interpretation of the Competitor.
3. The Competitors will be judged on color enhancement, fashion effect and overall visual presentation.

HAIRSTYLING: The hair may be of any length and may be dressed in an upward, downward, forward or backward direction, according to the competitor's theme.

There are 45 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. Competitors will report with the Model's hair preset if desired and ready to comb. The hair may be prepared in any manner deemed necessary by the Competitor. No pre-combing is allowed! All hair must be released, brushed and/ or combed during this segment.
2. The hair may be chemically prepared and cut prior to the Competition.

3. All finishing tools will be allowed for use on the Competition floor.
4. No wigs are allowed. Ornaments made from hair or other fibers are allowed but they should not cover more than 25% (one- fourth) of the head and they should not be prepared in advance in any way.
5. Hats may be worn by the Models, but remember, the Model's hair is one of the deciding factors. Decorative materials may be used.
6. Finishing products may be used to complete the style.

HAIRCUTTING: Haircutting will be exercised on the male Model only. The male Model's make-up and nail finishing can be completed prior to the start.

There are 45 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. The male Model must be in need of a cut, attired in Competition dress and have his hair prepared for cutting and styling.
2. At least 1" (one- inch) of interior hair must be cut. Not including the hairline.
3. The Model's hair length must be pre- approved by the Sages.
4. The Model's make-up may be completed during this time.
5. Finishing products may be used to complete the style.

Note - For the final judging, after each Team's narrative at the Judges Table, the Models may be positioned anywhere deemed appropriate on the Competition Floor. Make sure the Competitor's number is clearly visible.

COMPETITION GENERAL RULES

Each Competition Team may include one to four team members (not including the two models). In the event of 3 or fewer teams, one overall award is given; 4-6 teams- two overall awards are given; 7 or more teams- three overall awards are given.

1. Competitions are open to all students with less than 1250 hours with proof of enrollment in a licensed Barber/Beauty school or apprentice program with entry.
2. All models and all competitors must sign a PABCA Model Release Form.
3. Models under 18 years of age must complete the PABCA Parental Consent Form along with the PABCA Model Release Form.
4. Only the team members will be allowed to work on the model. A different team member may work on different competition segments during the allotted time. More than one team member may work on the model at the same time.
5. The International 30 Point Scoring System will be used for judging. The Chairman of the Jury's scores will be used to break any ties. The jury's decision is final.
6. The Competition Director and the Competition Committee shall determine any rule not herein provided for. The decision of the Committee is final.
7. The competitor must sign and submit the official entry application and the required fee. In doing so, the competitor agrees to abide by the jury's decision as final.
8. Entry fee refunds or credits may be issued, if approved by the Competition Chairman.
9. Any competitor who arrives after the scheduled starting time may be disqualified, and entry fees may not be refunded. All competitors and models are advised to report to the registration area at least 30 minutes prior to the competition's start.
10. It is each competitor's responsibility to secure and furnish their own models at their own expense, as well as all tools and supplies needed.
11. Competitors may bring table lights, power strips and extension cords.
12. Any type of covering may be worn over the model's wardrobe and may be removed before the final judging.
13. All competition work must be done on the competition floor, unless otherwise specified.
14. No entry material will be returned and will become property of the PABCA.
15. Coaching by an audience member for any competitor will result in a deduction of that competitor's score by the Sages.
16. A 1500 watt (or lower) electrical appliance is recommended.
17. Once models report for the competition, they will not be released until the completion of the judging unless accompanied by a Sage.
18. When time is called, all competition activity must stop and neither the competitor or the model will be permitted to spray or touch the finished product.
19. Award winning competitors must remain for photos.
20. Water and energy drinks are allowed on the floor during the competition.
21. All judging is to be done at the completion of the final phase of the competition.
22. No cell phones or other electronic devices may be used by the competitors or the models during the competition time.
